



Manor Visitation Protocol

Effective 1-8-22 per California Public Health Department regulations.

Family Virtual and Indoor or Patio visits are by appointment, please contact activities staff to schedule a time or for any questions: snfactivities2@santateresitainc.com

- Be screened for fever and COVID-19 symptoms, wear appropriate facial covering, and perform hand hygiene when in the facility.
- Between Jan.7-Feb. 7, 2022, prior to visitation at a facility for both indoor and outdoor visits, all visitors who are two years of age or older, regardless of vaccination or booster status, must provide with proof of the following:
 - i. a negative PCR test within 48 hours prior to entry
 - OR
 - ii. A negative FDA-approved Antigen test results taken within 24 hours of entry
 - OR for All indoor visits:
 - iii. **1/8/22: INDOOR VISITS CANCELLED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE DUE TO DIRECTIVE FROM LA DEPT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.**

When the resume indoor visits, all visitors who are five years of age or older, must provide the facility with their proof of all recommended doses including the primary series, and, if eligible, a booster dose per Table below:

COVID-19 Vaccine	Primary vaccination series	When does a person become booster-eligible?	Which vaccine booster dose to receive?
Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech	1st and 2nd doses	Booster dose 6 months after 2 nd dose	Any of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized in the United States may be used for the booster dose, but either Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech are preferred.
Johnson and Johnson [J&J]/Janssen	1st dose	Booster dose 2 months after 1 st dose	Any of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized in the United States may be used for the booster dose, but either Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech are preferred.

Manor Facility Visitor Guidelines:

- 2 visitors per indoor visit (2 max/visit)
- 4 visitors per outdoor visit (4 max/visit)
- Please submit your COVID-19 vaccine status prior to your visit to the activities department at snfactivities2@santateresitainc.com
