



## Manor Visitation Protocol

*Effective 2-18-22 per California Public Health Department regulations.*

- Family Virtual and Indoor or Patio visits are by appointment, please contact activities staff to schedule a time or for any questions. [snfactivities2@santateresitainc.com](mailto:snfactivities2@santateresitainc.com)
- **All visitors seeking indoor visitation (Indoor visitation resuming 2/14/21) must continue to show proof of a negative FDA-approved SARS-CoV-2 test prior to entry, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination or booster status.** This is in force until LA County reaches the CDC's threshold for moderate community transmission.
  - A negative COVID-19 test prior to entry includes a negative lab-confirmed PCR test result taken within 2 days prior to entry OR a negative FDA-approved antigen test result taken within 1 day prior to entry.
  - All antigen tests, including both CLIA-waived and home over-the-counter (OTC) antigen tests, must be at minimum conducted in presence of facility staff who can verify the test result belongs to the visitor and conducted on the appropriate date/time.
  - Visitors who visit for multiple consecutive days are required to show proof of a negative FDA-approved SARS-CoV-2 test at least every third day (e.g., test on day 1, day 4, day 7, and so on).
  - Visitors who show documentation of recovery from COVID-19 within last 90 days (i.e., a positive COVID-19 viral test result on a sample taken no more than 90 days) are exempt from this requirement.
  - Outdoor visitation that does not involve entry into the facility no longer requires a negative SARS-CoV-2 test prior to the visit.
  - All general visitation, outdoors and indoors, must still follow [Table 2 in LAC DPH's COVID-19 Guidance](#).
  - All visitors, essential and general, must continue to adhere to measures laid out in [CDPH AFL 20-22](#) including the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention – entry screening, wearing a well-fitting face mask at minimum and any other recommended PPE, 6 ft physical distancing, hand hygiene, etc.

Essential visitation should be permitted indoor and outdoor for residents in all cohorts regardless of facility's outbreak status and vaccination status of resident/visitor provided infection prevention & control practices including entry screening are followed.

**\*All visitors who are five years of age or older, must provide the facility with their proof of all recommended doses including the primary series, and, if eligible, a booster dose per Table below:**

<b>COVID-19 Vaccine</b>	<b>Primary vaccination series</b>	<b>When does a person become booster-eligible?</b>	<b>Which vaccine booster dose to receive?</b>
Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech	1st and 2nd doses	Booster dose 6 months after 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose	Any of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized in the United States may be used for the booster dose, but either Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech are preferred.
Johnson and Johnson [J&J]/Janssen	1st dose	Booster dose 2 months after 1 <sup>st</sup> dose	Any of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized in the United States may be used for the booster dose, but either Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech are preferred.

**Manor Facility Visitor Guidelines:**

- 2 visitors per indoor visit (2 max/visit)
- 4 visitors per outdoor visit (4 max/visit)
