



Cottages Visitation Protocol

Effective 2-18-22 per California Public Health Department regulations.

1. All visits need to be pre-scheduled at least 24 hours in advance with Sr. Gianna rcfeactivities@santateresitainc.com or at 626-863-6217. Email preferred, but please call or text, too. If it is impossible to plan your visit in advance, we are willing to work with you.
2. NEW: Visitors seeking IN-ROOM visitation only need to either
 - a. Provide proof that they are fully vaccinated (see definition below) OR,
 - b. If unvaccinated or incompletely vaccinated, provide documentation of a negative COVID test within 1 day of visitation for antigen tests or within 2 days of visitation for PCR tests.

Either a PCR or antigen/home test (FDA approved) is acceptable. Bring a hard copy or email your negative result to Sr. Gianna rcfeactivities@santateresitainc.com prior to your visit.

3. NEW: Visits that are OUTDOORS: No additional requirements at this time - except to wear masks at all times. Also, limit of up to 4 visitors.
4. All visitors must fill out the questionnaire and have a temperature check prior to the visit. All visitor's check-in at the Cottage MAIN ENTRYWAY. After visitor(s) has passed screening, proceed to visit area.
5. Currently visits are **ONLY** permitted in the following locations:
 - a. The Outside Patio (up to 4 visitors)
 - b. In the resident's room (up to 2 visitors)

Reminder: 6 ft. distancing, mask wearing, and good hand hygiene are still the best ways to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

**Unvaccinated or incompletely vaccinated visitors with history of COVID-19 within the prior 90 days may provide documentation of recovery from COVID-19 in lieu of testing.*

For indoor visitors who are unvaccinated, and who visit for multiple consecutive days, proof of negative test is only required every third day (meaning testing is only required on day one, day 4, and day 7, and so on).

Fully vaccinated means: 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine. No booster required.
